



Scholarship Fund Eligibility Criteria

- 1) Candidate must be a U.S. resident.
- 2) Candidate must be a May or June 2011 High School Graduate entering a 4-year College or University.
- 3) Candidate must have a 2.75 or better GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- 4) Candidate must submit a copy of their High School transcript with the accumulative GPA average.
- 5) Candidate must submit a Letter of Recommendation (letter must be from a Teacher, Employer or Professional with an organization in which you are a member).
- 6) Candidate must submit an Academic Resume (to include volunteer work, club associations and employment history).
- 7) Candidate must submit a 500 word essay in their OWN words using the Topic: **The M. A. Lee Scholarship focuses on the fact that "Success has no boundaries". As a potential recipient, you will be a representative of the organization and its founder. Understanding the history of the scholarship fund, how would you best represent and honor the scholarship?**
- 6) Candidate must submit all the above along with the Application Packet by U. S. Mail on or before April 30, 2011. Applications submitted in any manner other than U.S. Mail will not be accepted.
